Camelot Recreation Center

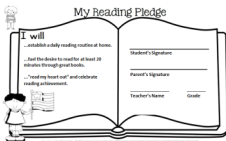
The Camelot Rec. Center will only be opened **Monday, October 10th from 2 –6 p.m.** in observance of Columbus Day.

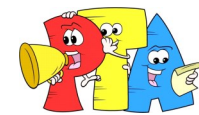
