## **General Information for School Parties and Treat**

### **Days for Room Parents, Parents & Guardians**

This guideline should be followed in successfully planning classroom parties and treats. Two class parties and three treats are permitted during the school year. Just a reminder that all party and treat days must be planned with the classroom teacher. Due to many food related allergies, food items must be store bought and remain in its original packaging.

Because of space and time limitations, no more than two room parents should be present for class treats in the cafeteria for Thanksgiving, Valentine's Day and Spring Holidays. For the classes that have more than one room parent, consider rotating visits so that all may participate during the year.

1. All parties are to be given between 12:30pm and 2:00pm and may be held in the classroom. All parents are asked to leave the building by 2:20pm prior to our dismissal at 2:29pm
2. Treats are to be given during the class lunch time in the cafeteria or given to the teacher to distribute to the students to take home.
3. Parties and treats should consist of store bought items and remain in the original packaging due to student allergies, known & unknown.
4. Notes/letters from the room parent regarding class parties/treats must be approved by the principal. You can send a copy via the classroom teacher or bring a copy to the office.

## **Parties/Treats**

### **Winter Party/End of the Year Party**

Will be scheduled on designated days (information provided by the classroom teacher). Please contact the teacher before making any arrangements.

## **Treats**

### **Fall, Thanksgiving, Valentine's Day and Spring Holiday Treats:**

#### **Fall/Thanksgiving**

Treats may be served on designated days in the cafeteria or given to the classroom teacher to send home with the students at the end of the school day.

#### **Valentine's Day**

Valentines may be exchanged among the students as planned by the teacher. Please talk with the teacher in advance to find out what they have planned.

#### **Spring**

Treats may be served on designated days in the cafeteria. K-2 may have an Egg Hunt.

## **Crafts**

When crafts are planned for the students, please ask the teacher in advance. Crafts should not exceed 30mins.

Just a reminder that all party and treat days must be planned with the classroom teacher. Due to many food related allergies, food items must be store bought and remain in its original packaging. Please do not send in bubble gum, unwrapped candy or balloons. All treats and parties must be planned with the teacher.

## **Student Birthdays**

Parents may send (bring) a small treat to be served during lunch time, after communicating with the classroom teacher for approval for that day. Kindergarten birthday treats may be sent to the teacher to be served in the classroom. Please do not bring party decorations or favors. The teacher will recognize student birthdays in the classroom. Parents should not send in birthday invites to school to be distributed.
