Paul Charles Harris Memorial Scholarship

All seniors who plan to attend college are encouraged to apply, especially soccer players and students with learning differences. Applicants should be able to get along with others, be respectful, have a positive and friendly attitude, and be dedicated to earning a college degree. [Application](#) requires three letters of recommendation. Quantity and value of scholarships are not yet determined. Applications are due April 30, 2012.

Chesapeake Democratic Women, Nora W. Davenport Scholarship

Chesapeake high school senior females are eligible to apply. Application requires typed statement of future goals, transcript, and two letters of recommendation. One \$500 scholarship will be awarded. [Applications](#) are due May 20, 2012.

Seniors with sickle cell disease who have been accepted to an accredited Virginia college/university/trade school are eligible to apply. Application requires doctor's statement, copy of acceptance letter from college/school, and essay. If selected, recipient must volunteer 25 hours with the Sickle Cell Association of the Peninsula. Thomas Harrell, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Applicant must be a current member or dependent of a current member of Tidewater Virginia Anglers Club. Membership must be for a minimum of two consecutive years. ACCESS Last Dollar Scholarships

One application is required to apply for several scholarships that will be awarded. Most of the scholarships require students to have a 2.5 GPA. One scholarship-Yagen Scholarship- requires a minimum 2.0 GPA and is available for students attending a technical, career, or proprietary school. Application requires transcript, College Acceptance Letter, Student Aid Report, Financial Aid Award Letter, and ACCESS Student Release Form. W. Randolph Nichols Scholarship

Seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA and plans to major in education may be eligible to apply. Applicants must have been Chesapeake residents for entire senior year. Application requires transcript, most recent report card, copy of college acceptance letter, three letters of reference, and one-page essay. Applicant must be a graduate from Chesapeake, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, or Virginia Beach. Application requires transcript, resume, and essay. See application for essay details. [Applications](#) are due to ASQ by May 15, 2012.

2012 Doug Picott Memorial Scholarship for Southeastern Elementary School

Applicants must be CPS graduates, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, who attended Southeastern Elementary. Application requires essay, two letters of recommendation, transcript, school officials' signatures. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded. [Applications](#) are due May 4, 2012.

Helen C. Davenport Scholarship of the Great Bridge Chapter #155, Order of the Eastern Star

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and have taken honors/AP courses. Applicant must attend a Virginia college/university. Application requires transcript, 3 letters of recommendation, and biographical statement. Application has secondary school form to be completed by school counselor.
