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### WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- ◆ The target population is students from across Chesapeake who envision themselves pursuing a STEM-oriented career and/or who demonstrate a particular talent or interest in the field of technology.

### WHAT DO WE HAVE TO OFFER?

- ◆ The Governor's STEM Academy will focus on three career pathways:
  - ◆ Engineering and Technology
  - ◆ Global Entrepreneurship and Technology
  - ◆ Programming and Software Development
- ◆ The Governor's STEM Academy will offer the opportunity for students to earn Industry Certifications.
- ◆ The Governor's STEM Academy is a four year program that operates as a school-within-a-school.

### HOW MANY GET ACCEPTED?

- ◆ Approximately sixty freshmen will be accepted into the Governor's STEM Academy for the 2017-2018 school year.

### IS TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED?

- ◆ Transportation will be provided by Chesapeake Public Schools to all students accepted into the Governor's STEM Academy.
