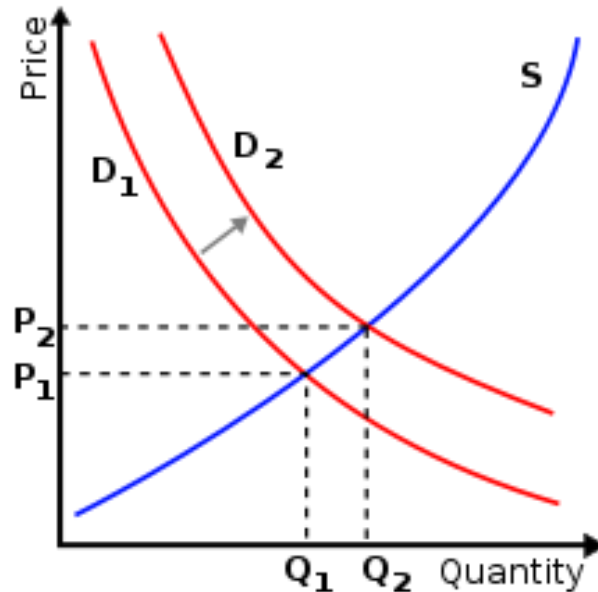


# AP MICROECONOMICS

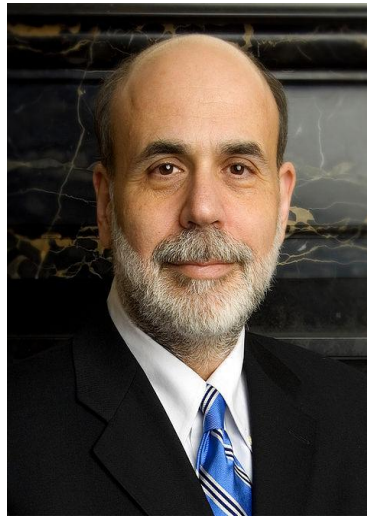
