



Drama Classes At Hickory High School



Students will study all facets of the theatre.

Each quarter students study drama, not just from a textbook, but also through the insight of an experienced teacher, actor, and director, and group experiences.

We also read mini plays and watch movie musicals in class.

There is only one test per quarter and it is inclusive of all areas covered during that grading period.

In addition, students complete a project each quarter. These projects include an Oral Interpretative Reading, a 1-3 minute monologue, a make up demonstration, and a 3-5 minute duet scene.



Drama II, III, IV, V & Acting Techniques

This class emphasizes creative imagination through the development of fundamental acting skills integrated into individual and ensemble theatrical performances.

Students will select an area of mastery in conjunction with the student directed production to which they are assigned.

This will require the study of advanced production techniques, a variety of acting techniques and methodologies.

Work is assigned from the textbook, online work resources (Desire To Learn / D2L) in addition to the production.



Drama IV & V Honors

Students who complete additional assignments, attend and critique live productions are offered honor's credit (1.5 credits per semester).
