

Occupational Exploration Internship Program Indian River High School

The student's internship provides a structured, supervised experience within a career cluster.

Students have the opportunity to:

- Learn the procedures, policies, and daily activities typical in a particular
- Gain exposure to how classroom theories and concepts can be applied to real world situations
- Learn the values and expectation of work-oriented society.
- Grow in maturity, sophistication, and responsibility.
- Obtain entry-level experience and a level of readiness for higher or more skilled positions within the profession.

Requirements for the Program:

- Students must have a 2.8 or higher grade point average
- Students must be able to work part-time the entire school year.
- Students will be responsible for completing projects and keeping track of their work hours
- Students will be interviewed by the Marketing Coordinator and by the business offering the internship program.
