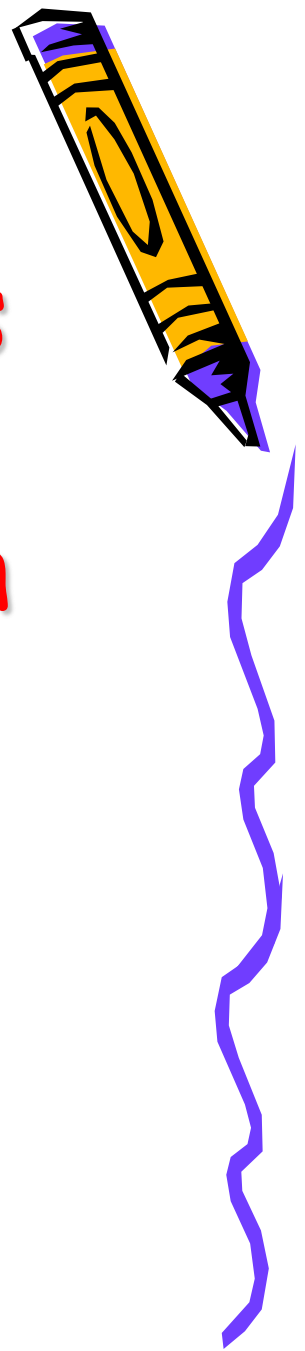


# Chesapeake Public Schools Field Trip Chaperone Guidelines and Orientation for Elementary Schools

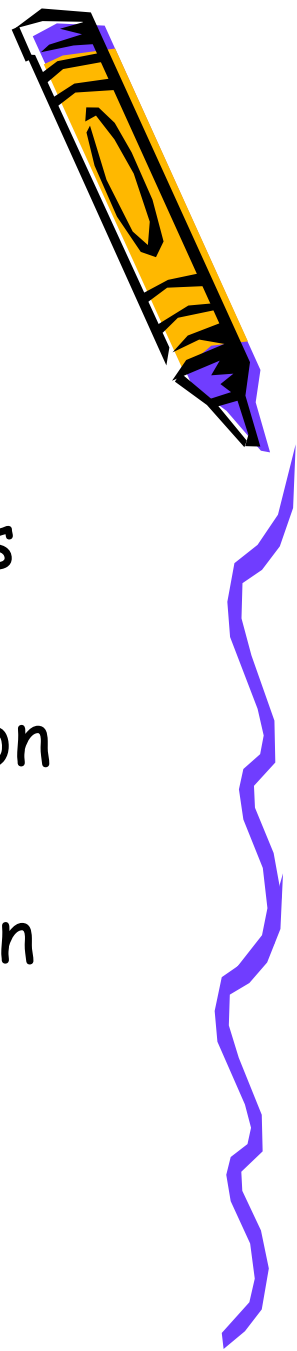


# Please note

# Guidelines for Field Trip Chaperones (Non-School Employees)



- You must reflect a positive attitude
- You must be supportive of the decisions made by the teacher
- You must use good judgment and common sense
- You should assist in maintaining order on the bus



- You must be aware of and strive to achieve the expectations of the teacher and the students
- The safety of the students is the number one priority
- In case of an accident or injury, ask for assistance and notify the teacher
- If you have a question, ask the teacher





- You should have a cell phone with you at all times
- You should have the teacher's cell phone number, as well as, the school's phone number
- You should dress in accordance with the school policy

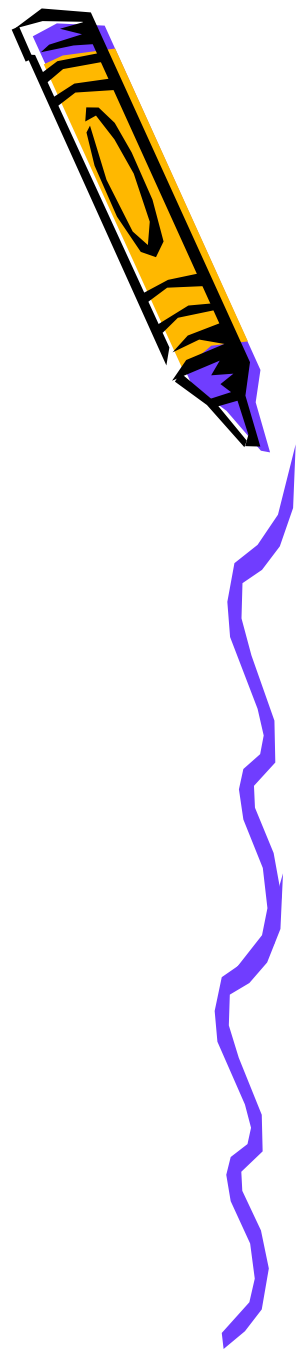


# Specific Duties:

# *SUPERINTENDENT'S DO'S AND DON'TS*



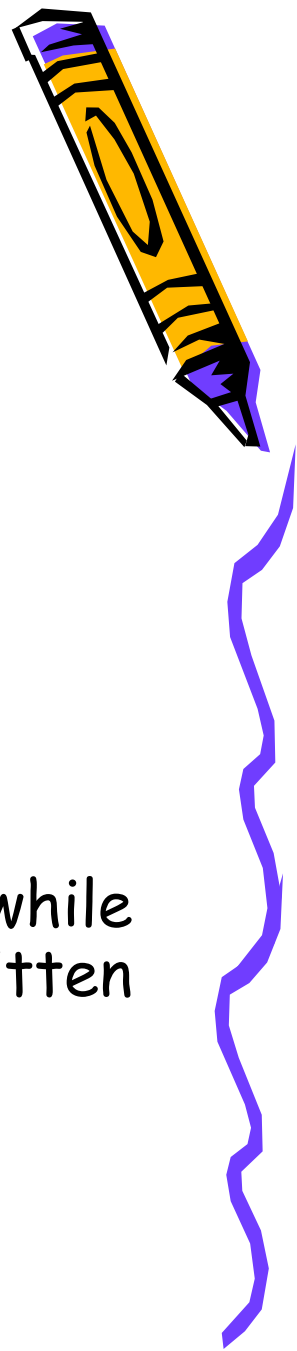
## Do's

- Never administer medications of any kind
- Never take photos of another parents child while on a field trip for any reason without written consent of affected parents and students.
