

Homecoming Parade Float Information “Bruins Back to the Future”

- All floats must pertain to the **Bruins Back to the Future** theme.
- Our rivals are the Great Bridge Wild Cats.
- All floats must face the passenger side of the truck.
- Floats may not exceed one level. No multi-level floats allowed.
- Trailers may not exceed twenty feet in length. All entries must be able to fit through the stadium gates.
- Floats will be judged on the criteria stated below.
- The top 3 winning floats will participate in a Pre-game parade inside the stadium.
- Banners or floats from each grade level will participate in the Pre-game parade.
- **Everyone entering the stadium with the winning floats must purchase a game ticket to enter.**
- No one will be allowed to exit the stadium and re-enter.

Banner Contest

Any WBHS club or other parade unit that is not entering a float in the parade may participate in the banner contest. Entries must represent the club or organization and the Homecoming theme. A committee will judge the banners before the parade based upon the criteria stated below. **Everyone entering the stadium with the winning banner must purchase a game ticket to enter.** No one will be allowed to exit and re-enter.
