Students must be cleared of any obligations before they will be allowed to sign up for prom. A list of students who owe money will be available at the prom sign up table. If your name is on the list, you will not be able to sign up unless you have a receipt showing that the debt was paid in full. Students should see Mrs. Johnson in the main office to pay their debts.

**\*\*\*STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE A PERMISSION FORM BEFORE THEY WILL BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER FOR PROM\*\*\***

- *Permission Forms are available in the main office and guidance. Each junior and senior will complete his or her own permission form. Freshman, sophomore and outside guests will be listed on the form with their Junior/Senior date and will not need a separate form. Students should bring the completed permission form with them to the registration table.*
- *Guests must be not be older than 20. Guests who are not WBHS students must have the form signed by their current employer, a clergyman or a school official from their high school or college. Parent signature is required but family members may not sign as a reference.*
- *If the guest is in the military or away at college, you must allow time to send the form, have it signed and returned.*

**A picture ID will be required for all guests and students who attend prom. Those without ID will NOT be admitted. Prom requires formal attire.** The dress code will be strictly enforced. Formal attire means a tuxedo or suit and tie or a dressy (short or long) dress that is not too revealing as well as appropriate footwear.

There is to be **NO smoking** and **NO alcoholic beverages** should be consumed prior to or brought into the prom.

**Lewd, suggestive or sexually explicit dancing will not be permitted.**

All students and guests must abide all Chesapeake Public Schools & WBHS school rules and policies while attending prom. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the student and/or guest being asked to leave immediately and may also result in disciplinary consequences. **Any guest or student evicted for any reason will not be permitted to return to Prom or to attend After Prom activities and parents will be notified.**

**No student or guest will be allowed to exit and return into the Half Moone unless you are accompanied by a security officer or administrator.**

**AFTER PROM PARTY - All prom attendees are invited to attend the After Prom Party at AMF Bowling Lanes. You must have a signed After Prom permission slip form to enter the party. After Prom Permission slips will be available at the prom registration table and in the main office.**
