Temporary Inclusion of Grassfield High School within the Deep Creek/Hugo A. Owens Middle Schools Planning Area

As discussed previously, for the purpose of planning for school facility needs, the city has been divided into seven school planning areas. These seven school planning areas are identified with the middle school attendance zones and associated high school attendance zones. Middle school attendance zones are generally not identical to the high school attendance zones.

For example, Great Bridge High School receives students from Great Bridge Middle School, Crestwood Middle School, and Hickory Middle School, and Oscar Smith High School receives students from both Crestwood Middle School and Greenbrier Middle School. It is important to note, as new high school facilities continue to be constructed, students will come from a minimum of two middle schools to create the student population at the new high school. Grassfield High School, which opened in September 2007, also receives students from three middle schools -- Hugo A. Owens Middle School, Great Bridge Middle School and Hickory Middle School.

Because historical enrollment data is maintained by middle/high school planning areas, it is not possible to present historical data by year showing the growth in enrollment for grades 9-12 within the new high school boundaries for Deep Creek High School, Great Bridge High School, Hickory High School, and Grassfield High School. Generally, five years of historical data is necessary. To allow time to obtain historical data, Grassfield High School will continue to be included within the Deep Creek/Hugo A. Owens Middle School Planning Area until a new school planning area is created.
