- Students are invited to submit an 8 ½" x 11" (standard US letter paper) or 22 x 28" (poster board) poster to participate in CPS-SNS National Nutrition Month Poster Contest, while gaining experience in creative competition.
- Students may submit **one** poster representing appropriate grade level. **No** real food permitted on poster.
- Each poster must include the official CPS-SNS poster contest entry form attached to the back of the poster.
- Posters will be turned in to the student's current school no later than the previously listed deadline (Friday, 3/17/17).

- Kindergarten
- 1st Grade
- 2nd Grade

Brackets for Judging:

- 3rd Grade
- 4th Grade
- 5th Grade

- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners at each grade level will receive a certificate and prize. (18 total winners) SNS and a community support judging panel will select the 18 winning posters. Winners will be notified no later than **Friday, March 31, 2017**. Prizes and certificates will be presented during the month of April.
- The school with the highest percent participation will receive a prize.
- The Winning Posters will proudly be displayed at Chesapeake Regional Medical Center and Chesapeake City Hall during the months of April and May 2017.
