# SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION 2011

## Middle School Students Crestwood Middle School

### BASIC INFORMATION

For students in grades 6-8 who are scheduled to go to Crestwood Middle School for summer school, the first session will begin Monday, June 27, 2011. The second session will begin July 18, 2011. Courses are designed for ten days. The complete schedule is listed on the back of this page. Courses meet 8:00 a.m.- 12:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Schools will be closed on Fridays. Schools will also be closed on Monday, July 4, 2011. **The courses will only be offered if there is sufficient enrollment.**

### MIDDLE SCHOOL COURSES

**These courses are offered ONLY to students who attend Chesapeake Public Schools** and need courses in sixth, seventh, or eighth-grade English, mathematics, science, or social studies. There is no fee charged for these courses. Each sixth, seventh, or eighth-grade class will meet for ten days. A student may take two courses if permission is obtained from his or her principal. To be eligible to repeat a sixth, seventh, or eighth-grade class, a student must have made an "E" in the course. A student who made a "D" must have the permission of his or her school principal. The final decision on student eligibility for a repeat course is made by the home school principal.

### ENRICHMENT COURSES

**These courses are offered to all middle school students. There is a fee of \$150 per course for Chesapeake residents. Chesapeake Public School students must register between April 11, 2011 and April 15, 2011 at their current school. Chesapeake students who attend private school must register at Crestwood Middle School between April 11, 2011 and April 15, 2011 and need to show proof of residency when they enroll. These courses will only be offered if there is sufficient enrollment.**

### REGULATIONS

The usual regulations on attendance and tardiness will apply to summer school students. Parents and students need to be aware of the attendance and discipline policy. As during the regular school session, we are governed by school board policy that requires the student to attend the current session for a minimum number of days. If the student fails to meet these requirements, he or she may not receive a passing grade for that session. In the summer session this requirement means that a student cannot miss more than two days.

**Students will not be excused to attend conferences nor leave summer school early for vacation, and early final tests will not be permitted.**

Since participation at summer school is not mandatory, students who present discipline problems within the classroom, in the school, or on school grounds will not be permitted to continue in attendance.

### TRANSPORTATION

Limited bus transportation will be provided for summer school students to Crestwood Middle School. The bus schedules can be viewed on the Chesapeake Public Schools website the week prior to the beginning of summer school.

### HOW TO REGISTER

Chesapeake Public Schools middle school students should contact their guidance counselors for help in registration beginning May 2, 2011. Registration will be completed by June 16 at their home school. Registration will also be conducted at Crestwood Middle School from June 20 – June 23, 2011. However, before registering at the summer school site, it is necessary for students to obtain a registration form at the school they regularly attend.
